WARNING: HAZARD OF FLOODING- Always shut off seacocks before leaving boat unattended. Double clamp all hose fittings below waterline, check hose clamps frequently for integrity. Refer to toilet instruction manual for below water line installation of toilet.

Knock Out Odors Kit includes:

3 quart tank, metering valve with check valve, fittings, 1/4" hose, 22 oz bottle of Cleans Potties (C.P.) and a 22 oz bottle of Kills Odor (K.O.).

OPERATION:

Dispenser tank adds a preset amount of diluted C.P. with every flush. Bacteria introduced by C.P. breaks down organic matters in the inlet hose and bowl rim that cause sulfide generating bacteria (rotten egg smell). This bioactive formula stops the generation of odor without the use of chemicals such as chlorine or formaldehydes.

Adding K.O. through the toilet after each pump out eliminates odors from the holding tank and discharge hose.


Sani/Flex® odor shield sanitation hose (SFH) is recommended for preventing any odors permeating through hose.

Installation:


Locate deodorizing tank as per fig 1,2, 3 or 4, secure tank with screws.

Warning: Refer to toilet instruction manual to determine required vented loop height.

- 2. Install T check valve in the suction side of pump, secure hose with clamps.
- Connect 1/4" hose. 3.
- 4. Fill up the tank with clean water.
- Close metering valve completely and open 5. 1/4 turn.
- 6. Flush toilet and adjust metering valve until you get approximately 3 flushes per line.
- Refill tank and add 4.5 ozs of C.P. per tank. 7.
- 8. Flush toilet and check for leaks.



Manual toilet above water line - Tank MUST NOT be mounted higher than 12" above bowl





Electric Toilet above water line - Tank MUST NOT be mounted higher than 12" above bowl


Refill:

- Add 4.5 ozs of C.P. directly into dispenser tank.
- After every pump out, flush 4 ozs of K.O. per 25 gallons of holding tank capicity through the toilet (see bottle label for complete instructions).

Note: K.O. works best when holding tank has adequate ventilation.








Manual toilet below water line - Top of tank MUST not be below top of vented loop
